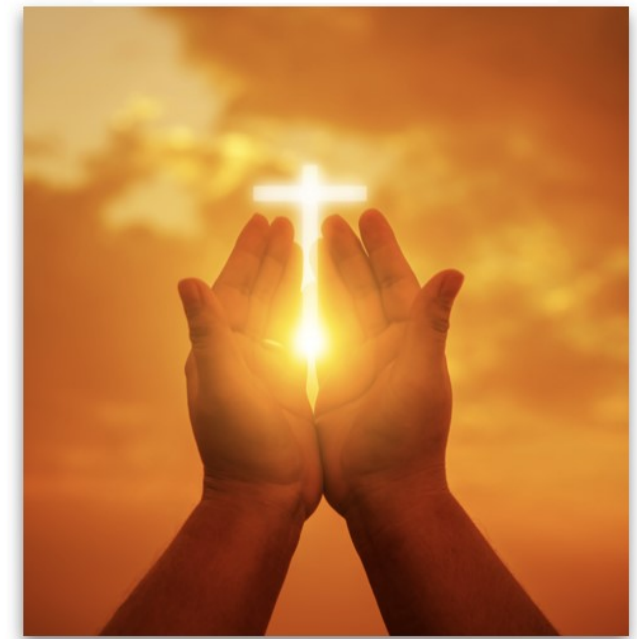

BIG CANOE CHAPEL COMMITTEES

Activities Committee

The Activities Committee plans special Chapel events, such as dinners and receptions following funeral services and memorial services.

Benevolence Committee

As a component of Big Canoe Chapel's outreach, the Benevolence Committee seeks to support charitable and faith-based organizations primarily in Dawson and Pickens Counties.

Christian Education Committee

The Christian Education Committee provides opportunities for Spiritual Growth based on the basic principles of the Christian Faith in an atmosphere conducive to multi-denominational worship. The primary vehicles for this growth are: Children and Adult Sunday School classes, Vacation Bible School, and related children's activities.

Cemetery Committee

The Cemetery Committee oversees the maintenance and upkeep of the cemetery.

Communications Committee

The Communications Committee supports the Chapel's mission by ensuring that key Chapel initiatives are communicated effectively so as to achieve Chapel leadership's desired outcomes. They promote working relationships with key Chapel "communication" groups to include information and training on Trustee approved communication guidelines, branding guidelines, and information and advice on use of the various communications channels of the Chapel.

Endowment Committee

The Endowment Committee sets policies for and raises funds for the Big Canoe Chapel Endowment Fund by actively soliciting endowment funds, reviewing restricted and unrestricted endowment gifts and by establishing investment policies.

Finance Committee

The Chapel Finance Committee works with the treasurer in the preparation of the recommended annual budget and in the development and execution of all financial policies of the Chapel; presents the Board of Trustees approved annual budget to the membership of the Chapel; recommends a public accounting firm to conduct the annual audit of the Chapel's financial records to ensure compliance with all IRS and other government regulations.

Library Committee

The Library Committee oversees the Chapel's library program and is responsible for the acquisition, cataloging, and maintenance of the collection.

Meditation Park/Terraces Committee

The Meditation Park Committee provides broad oversight of the use of park property and coordination among the various divisions of the park, including the Platt Botanical Garden, Scout Hut, and Terraces. The committee is responsible for the planning of future development within the park, including new development and expansion or modification of any of the current divisions of the park.

Ministry Support Committee

The Ministry Support Committee is responsible for ensuring that each Chapel committee has a chairperson and when requested will assist in selection of committee members; periodically hosts a Ministry Fair to encourage participation on Chapel committees; selects members of the annual Trustee Election Committee

Missions Committee

The Chapel Missions Committee identifies, evaluates, selects, and approves the disbursement of all mission funds to worthy Christian and humanitarian causes.

Personnel Committee

The Personnel Committee assists the Board of Trustees and the Senior Pastor with the recruitment and hiring of all Chapel employees (except the Senior Pastor) and will determine the number of staff members needed by the Chapel.

Property Committee

The Property Committee manages the maintenance and upkeep of all Chapel properties, including the Terraces. It is responsible for reviewing all proposals involving property (additions, expansion, etc.) prior to submission to the Board of Trustees.

Scholarship and Education Committee

As part of Big Canoe Chapel's outreach, the Scholarship and Education Committee is responsible for encouraging and assisting the young people of Dawson and Pickens counties in furthering their education by awarding scholarships to graduating seniors. The committee recruits volunteer interviewers, schedules interviews, and arranges a special Service and Reception in recognition of all recipients.

Services Committee

This committee is responsible for supporting the worship services, including altar and communion, flowers, and ushers, and for securing the hosts for Stand-Around (social time).

Stewardship Committee

The Stewardship Committee encourages members to share their time, talent, and treasure to support the operations and outreach of the Big Canoe Chapel.

Technology Committee

The purpose of the Chapel Technology Committee is to support the Chapel's mission by optimizing, supporting, and promoting the use of technology resources and investments. We offer our collective efforts in worship as a "Technical Ministry" team.

Visitors and Membership Committee

The committee welcomes visitors and ensures new members are given information about Chapel programs helping them engage in activities and areas of service using their spiritual gifts. They also provide gift bags to new members and hosts new member luncheons.
