



Requirements

The Big Canoe Chapel announces the availability of scholarship funds to selected high school seniors in the class of 2024. **The primary criterion for determining the amount of the scholarships is family financial need and scholastic achievement.** Extracurricular activities and work experience are also taken into consideration.

WHO MAY APPLY FOR A BIG CANOE CHAPEL SCHOLARSHIP? Any student who:

- 1) is a resident of Pickens or Dawson County, and
- 2) is graduating from an accredited high school or home school program, and
- 3) wishes to further his/her education as a full-time student in a college, university or technical college.

TO BE CONSIDERED for a Big Canoe Scholarship, students must do the following:

- 1) Complete a Big Canoe Chapel application form obtainable at the Counselor's Office, or printed from <http://bigcanoechapel.com> (from menu at top of home page select Outreach, then Scholarships.) Application must be typed.
- 2) To be considered, the student must provide the Scholarship Committee with an official transcript of high school grades and ACT / SAT score. Applicants must be HOPE qualified, with a 3.25 GPA in core courses; and have 3 AP / dual enrollment credits or any combination of the 2.
- 3) Provide two written personal references: one from the school, such as a teacher, counselor, or administrator; and one from an adult outside the school or family.
- 4) Complete the Senior Profile. A school counselor will provide the necessary information to secure and complete the form. The completed form must be typed. Please be as specific as possible in responding to the questions.

- 5) Provide a letter of acceptance from the college or university of their choice (technical colleges not eligible). If not available by the application deadline, this may be mailed (10455 Big Canoe, Big Canoe, GA 30143) or faxed (470-273-7922) to the Chapel.
- 6) Senior Resume – 9th through 12th grade.
- 7) Set up an appointment for an interview. School counselors will assist with scheduling the student interviews, which will be conducted by a member of the Big Canoe Chapel Scholarship Committee.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

The complete application must be in the counselor's office by **NOON ON JANUARY 19, 2024**. Home schooled students and students not attending Pickens or Dawson County High Schools must submit their completed application to the Big Canoe Chapel office by **NOON ON FRIDAY, JANUARY 19, 2024**.
